Workshop 1

Emerging Through a Pandemic: What does it mean to be On Fire for Mission?

Bev Mason

Informed by some of the theology and thinking of the Keynote address, in this workshop we are going to look at applied theology, building confidence and resilience and the practical steps we might want to take/are taking to be missional and ministering in a post-pandemic world. Fr Richard will look at the way in which our understanding of learning in schools has developed over the last half century. He will look at ways that parishes and families can apply this in nurturing young Christians. He will particularly reflect on the spiritual experience of children and how to encourage children in their spiritual lives. He will reflect on his many years' experience of teaching Mindfulness/meditation to children from 4 – 18 year olds. The session will include practical suggestions for families and churches to enable children to take Christianity seriously and personally.

Workshop 3

Healing the Soul: The Sacrament of Reconciliation

Kathryn Fleming

"God forgives you, forgive others, forgive yourself" Most of us carry truck-loads of baggage around with us, which prevent us from being the people God calls us to be. In this session (more conversation than workshop) we'll explore some of the background to, and practicalities of the "Cinderella Sacrament" and how the process of naming our guilt and our wounds in the context of the Sacrament of Reconciliation can help us to grasp the truth of the forgiveness God offers so freely. Come armed with questions and we'll see where God takes us!
